



CALL FOR OCCUPATION OF INDUSTRIAL YARDS

FOR THE CHIPATA, KAFUE, KITWE, MANSA, MONGU, NDOLA, AND SOLWEZI INDUSTRIAL YARDS

The Government of the Republic of Zambia received financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) towards the implementation of the Skills Development and Entrepreneurship Project Supporting Women and the Youth in Zambia (SDEP-SWY) and has applied part of the funds to the development of Industrial Yards in Zambia through the Citizens Economic Empowerment Commission (CEEC).

CEEC has constructed eight (8) Industrial Yards in the following target districts; Chipata, Kafue, Kasama, Kitwe, Mansa, Mongu, Ndola, and Solwezi.

Following the earlier Call for Occupation for targeted citizens and companies to apply for business loans for embarking on light manufacturing ventures in the Industrial Yards, the Commission now wishes to receive unsolicited applications from targeted citizens and companies who did not apply in the initial call and are interested in occupying and commercially operating in the following Industrial Yards and specified sub-sectors of light manufacturing;

For example, applicants who wish to operate in the Ndola Industrial Yard should submit their applications at the CEEC office in Ndola. **APPLICATIONS THAT DO NOT FOLLOW THE STATED FORMAT, WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

NOTE: THIS CALL FOR OCCUPATION DOES NOT APPLY TO TARGETED CITIZENS AND COMPANIES THAT SUBMITTED APPLICATION FORMS IN THE EARLIER CALL FOR OCCUPATION.
